

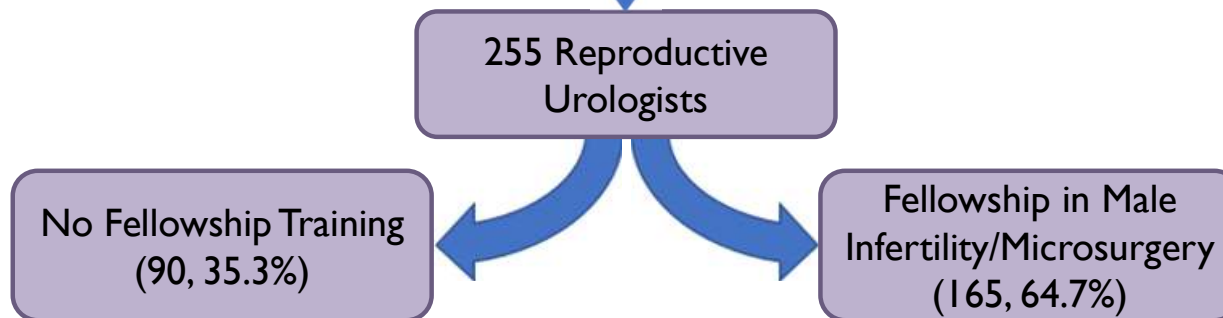
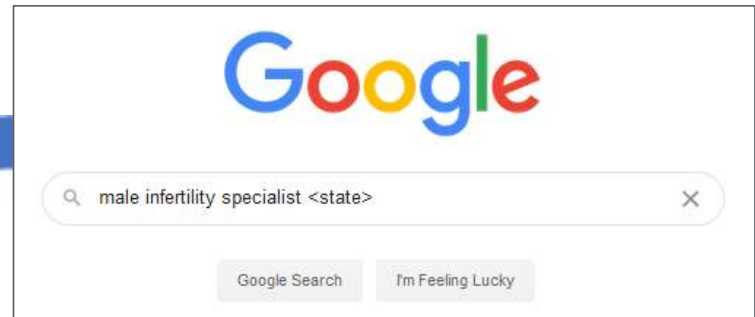

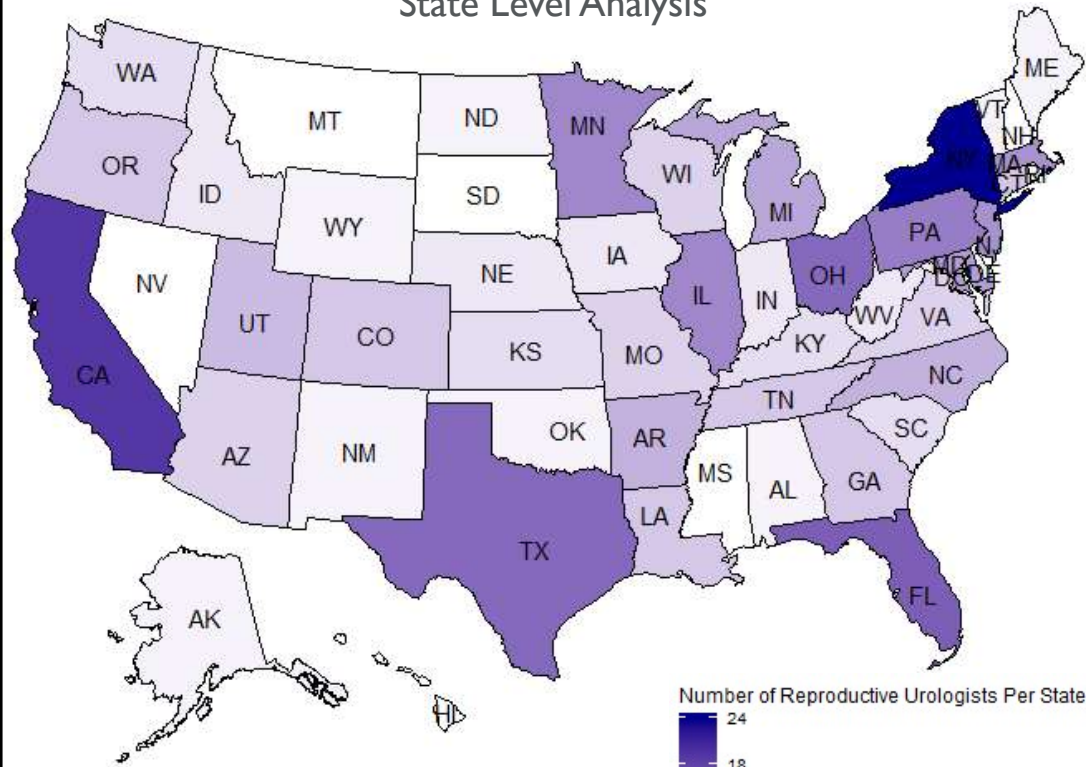


- More likely to offer

Chi-Square (all $p < 0.001$)

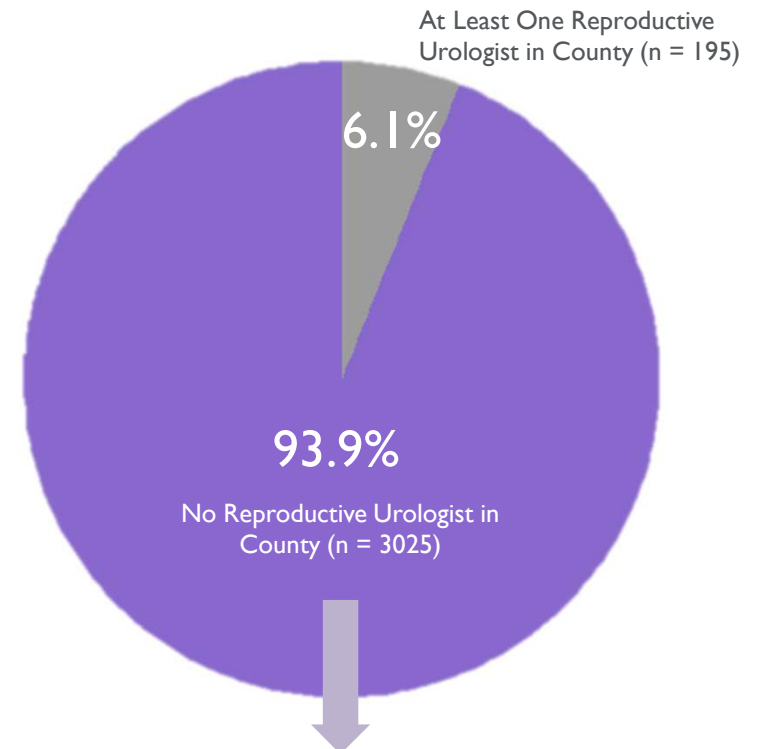
State Level Analysis
