

The 10-Year Priapism Consult Experience: Identifying Clearer Targets for Priapism Intervention

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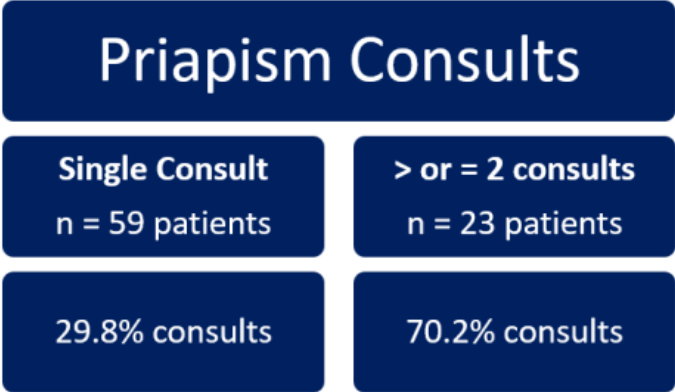
- Priapism is a urologic emergency in which prompt treatment is necessary
- Once previously noted to have an incidence of 0.34 – 1.5 per 100,000 now has had recent reports of an incidence of 5.3 – 8 per 100,000
- The annual costs of priapism for health care have been estimated to cost over \$120 million



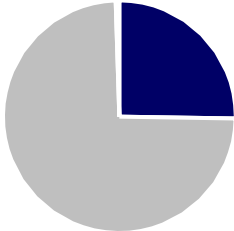
OBJECTIVE:

N = 198 consults, 82 unique patients

- A minority of patients account for the majority of consultations indicating a need for improved outpatient management of stuttering priapism.
- Timely transfer of patients from the OSH is another target for improvement of care as prolonged duration can lead to irreversible erectile dysfunction.
