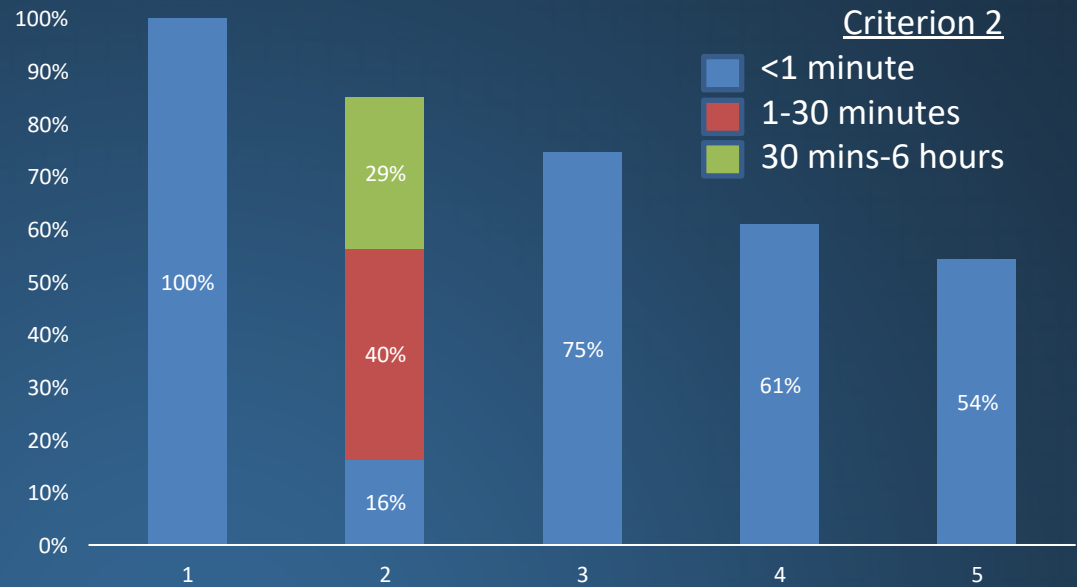

Percent of Sample Satisfying Five Diagnostic Criteria

Criterion	Description
1	≥ 1 of common symptoms of POIS
2	Symptoms occur immediately, soon, or within hours of ejaculation
3	Symptoms occur ≥90% of ejaculation events
4	Symptoms last 2-7 days
5	Symptoms disappear spontaneously

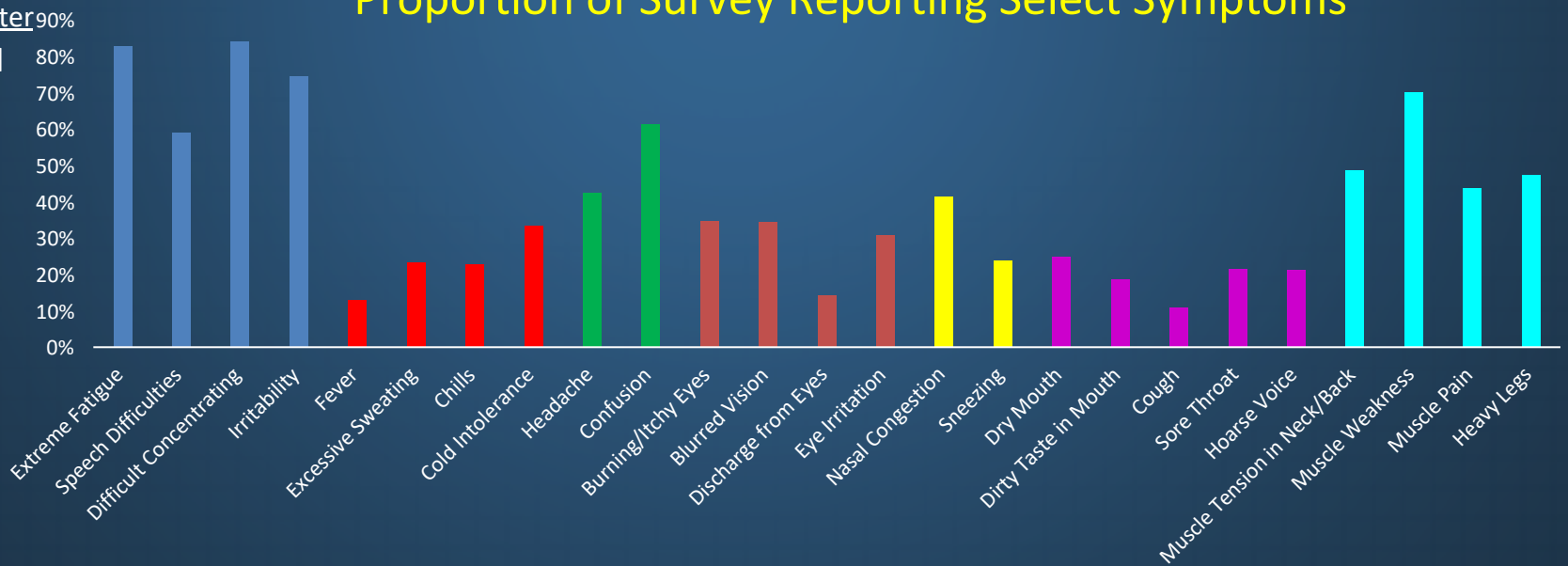

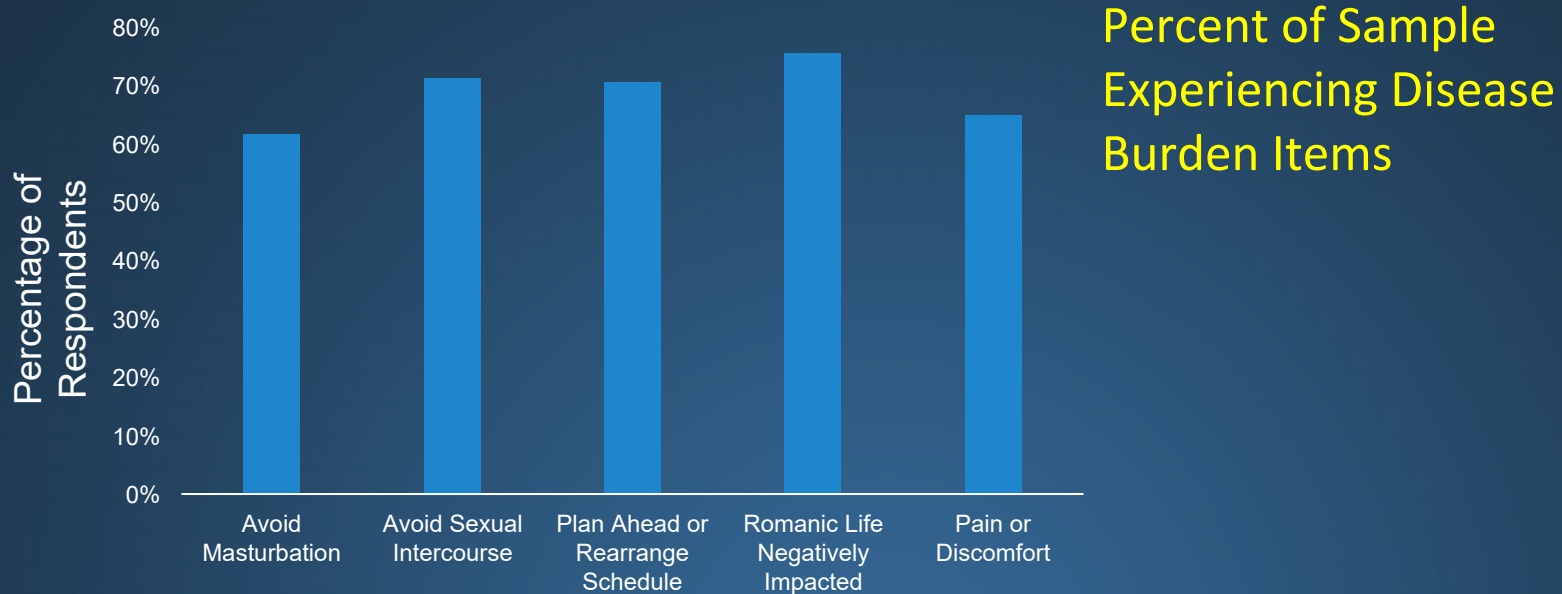


Proportion of Survey Reporting Select Symptoms
